++Cup Classes++

The 2022 Karl-Heinz Lansdowne Cup

Karl-Heinz Lansdowne Cup: Awarded to the highest point scorers across the 4 Championships. There are trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd to be presented at the Annual Dinner.

The 2022 Thirkell Cup

The Thirkell Cup: There are two versions of the Thirkell Cup, one for 350cc (Class 11c) and one for 500cc (Class 11b) Lansdowne bikes, and both are for riders aged over 60 (on the 1st of January of the competing season). There will be a trophy for 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class to be presented at the Annual Dinner.

++Championship Classes++

The 2022 Lansdowne British Championship

The Lansdowne British Championship (Class 11a): For pre 1963 500cc Group 1 racing motorcycles either original or replica but in a very period original specification. Thus, original sized wheels, exhaust systems, carburettors and so on are required plus the appearance of the bike must be very much in keeping with bikes which raced in the period. In order to make things even fairer riders have to use 'control' Avon tyres. The front and side number plates should be black numbers on a white background.

The 2022 Lansdowne Clubman's 500cc Championship

The Lansdowne Clubman's 500cc Championship (Class 11b): For pre 1963 Group 1 500cc racing motorcycles either original or replica in original condition but with permitted period type modifications. So, for example such bikes are allowed different sized wheels, exhausts, carburettors and so on as long as such modifications were used in period. Such modifications will be subject to a handicap system similar to that used in the Lansdowne Classic Series for a number of years. This is essentially how Lansdowne has always run and Group 2 machines are welcome. The front and side number plates should be black numbers on a yellow background.

The 2022 Lansdowne Avon 350cc Championship

The Lansdowne Avon 350cc Championship (Class 11c): For 350cc machines to the same specification as the Clubman's 500cc Championship. Again, this is essentially how Lansdowne has always run. This Championship is supported by Avon Tyres. Front and side number plates should be white numbers on a blue background.

The 2022 Lansdowne pre '55 Championship

The Lansdowne pre '55 Championship (Class 11d): This is a fairly new class for the Lansdowne Series and shares regulations with the very successful 50's spec races at the Goodwood Revival. This class is for very original pre 1954 Group 1 type bikes and pre 55 Group 2 bikes. The Lansdowne Series was inspired by the Revival from the start, so this is continuing a tradition. The front and side number plates should be white numbers on a red background.



++Non-Championship Class++

The 2022 Lansdowne Invitation Class

The 2022 Non-Championship Invitation Class (Class 11e): This invitation class is for machines which do not entirely conform to these regulations but may be invited to race with the Lansdowne Series if in the opinion of the Series Organisers (TLCS Ltd) they conform to certain criteria which are laid out in the Technical and Club Regulations
